What follows is an uncopyrighted, self-published book I printed in 1990. The 1990 printing contains errors in the earliest lineage on page 5.

Those errors have been perpetuated in numerous online genealogy databases throughout the internet as well as by the works of other authors who have copied the contents (with permission). Some of these errors were discovered and corrected almost immediately. Some have taken decades to discover. This book began with my dad's interest in his family's history conveyed to me as a young teen. He added his father's descendants to Maud Kelly's research and printed a pedigree on blueprint paper while he was taking drafting classes at what eventually became the University of Alabama in Birmingham (UAB).

This is a descendency book. Although it lists (unfortunately in error) the ancestors of Aaron Vincent and his wife Margaret Missouri Finch, the book begins with him and attempts to include all his known descendants up until about 1990 with a focus mostly on the children of Aaron's sons Oakley and Elmer.

Modern text editors were not available to me at the time of publication. After an education in Computer Science at the same university as my father, I used a UNIX visual line editor called "vi" and typed this into a UNIX mini-computer at work (we would call them servers nowadays). Hence, the formatting may seem a bit odd.

SECTION A

A word or two about the author.

In the twenty years I've been actively working on my family history, I've learned that records like this humble work are often widely dispersed and they often end up years later in the hands of people interested in family research who can't figure out who the author is or how to get in touch with him.

My name is Ronald Eugene Vincent. I am the third son of Wilburn Glenwood Vincent who is the eighth child of Oakley Vincent and Penoma Ophelia Seay (Section G).

I have been interested in family history since my early childhood but took an avid interest in it when I became a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints (Mormons) in 1969. I began gathering information in earnest in 1970 when I got out of the U.S. Air Force and I have spent at least a few days each year since then working mostly on my mother's ancestry (Warren, Blake, Smith, and Farmer families). I have not neglected my father's ancestry. Most of it except for the last few generations had already been thoroughly researched by Maude McClure Kelly (see Acknowledgements, Section B). Miss Kelly stopped working on genealogy actively the last few years of her life due to her health and, since she spent most of her time looking for deceased ancestors and was a peer of Oakley Vincent, several generations of Aaron Vincent's descendants have been omitted from her work.

SECTION B

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

I must mention how grateful I am for the many hours my mother and father have spent with me looking in old graveyards, researching old county records, and visiting relatives, distant and not-so-distant. I also wish to mention how grateful I am to have such a sweet and supportive wife. Thanks to her, I have been able to spend many hours doing research when she really needed me at home.

Thanks to a very dedicated family history buff, most of the work on the Vincent family had already been done many years before I began researching it. That dedicated researcher was Maude McClure Kelly. Miss Kelly started genealogical research (I am told) at about age 12 and remained a faithful and thorough researcher until a few years before her death at age 76.

Miss Kelly put two brothers through the Cumberland School of Law at Samford University and shortly before her death she gave all her research to the School's library, Special Collections Department. At the time the work was donated it was valued at six figures. It weighed more than a ton and took up 79 linear feet of library shelf space.

Needless to say any work on this line of the Vincent family would be lacking without mention of Miss Kelly's work. Anyone interested in going through her papers may do so. The library is located on the Samford University campus off Lakewood Drive not far from Brookwood Hospital in Birmingham. Their phone number is listed in the Birmingham Telephone Directory.

Along with the Vincent line, Miss Kelly has done much research on many related lines (Pace, Hawes, Ogburn, Bussey, and related families).

For data on Penoma Ophelia Seay and the Seay line the family history buff is referred to a small book entitled Descendants of Abraham Seay, by B. W. Seay IV. The book was printed in Richmond, Va. by the Lewis Printing Co. in 1966. A copy is in the possession of W. G. Vincent, of Hueytown, Ala.

SECTION C

WHERE WE CAME FROM

The ancestors of Aaron Vincent and their families
(as far back as they have been traced)

JOHN VINSON

The earliest Vincent ancestor mentioned in Miss Maude McClure Kelly's collection (the Bledsoe-Kelly Collection at the Samford University Library) is John Vinson who was married to Mary (surname unknown) before 1716. Little else is known about this earliest proven ancestor but he may not have been the first of our line to come to the New World. An Adrian Vincent is mentioned in a book of ships passengers (1600 - 1825) as having come to America from England in 1633.

THOMAS VINSON

John's eldest son Thomas is mentioned in a will probated in 1722. Thomas Vinson married a woman named Isabel and died in 1764. The spelling variation of "Vinson" may be confusing to some. The original spelling was "Vincent" according to Miss Kelly. Two ancestors Aaron and his mother Amelia show the spelling as "Vinson" in the pedigree my father has but these two were included on a copy of the First U.S. Census (1790) that Oakley Kevin Vincent picked up in Washington D.C. The spelling on the first census is "Vincent".

JOHN VINSON

Thomas had at least one son named John. John Vinson is said to have been from Brunswick County, Virginia. He married Amelia (surname unknown) and died in Johnston County, North Carolina in 1791. John does not appear on the First U.S. Census. Some censuses took years to complete. John was apparently dead before he was enumerated. He was discharged from Militia duty early during the Revolutionary War for age and infirmity.

John and Amelia had at least two sons. They were Aaron and Drury Vinson. Amelia and Aaron appear as Vincent on the 1790 Census as mentioned above and they are listed together showing that Amelia probably lived near Aaron but she is shown as a separate head of house. Drury is listed as probably living in another location apart from Aaron and Amelia. His name appears much earlier in the record.

AARON VINSON

More is known about Aaron Vinson. He was born in 1747. On the 11th of November 1761 he married Sarah Ogburn in Sussex County, Virginia. She was the daughter of John Ogburn of Sussex County, Virginia and Phoebe. Sarah's family has been traced back four additional generations to one Simon Ogburn. Sarah died about 1789 and Aaron died in 1791 both in Johnston County, North Carolina.

Aaron and Sarah had five children. John Vincent (our ancestor) who will be covered in more detail later; Allen Vincent who died in 1818 in Richmond, Virginia; Elizabeth Vincent who married Isaac Rosser; Mary Vincent who married Brittain Lockhart; and Charlotte (Lottie) Vincent who married Joel Lockhart on the 26th of October, 1794. Lottie died on Nov 4th, 1854. The Bledsoe-Kelly collection has more on the Rosser and Lockhart lines. Aaron Vinson was Justice of Johnston County from May 1777 until his death. Apparently the reason Aaron Vinson has no record of military service during the Revolutionary War is because of his civil service during that period.

None of Aaron and Sarah Ogburn Vinson's children's dates of birth are known except for John who was born in 1787 according to his tombstone. Therefore, it is not known which of the children was oldest. It is doubtful the oldest was John since he was born just two years before his mother died. Aaron and Sarah must have died when the children were young. A letter from Ida Vincent indicates they were raised by a relative.

JOHN VINCENT

Reverend John Vincent is indeed a most interesting gentleman. He was ordained a minister in the Methodist Episcopal Church, he fought in the Indian War in 1813 and he had 16 children (not necessarily in that order).

He married Nicey (probably a nickname for 'Eunice') Hawes in 1811 in Lincoln County, Georgia. No record of another marriage has been found. It is therefore assumed that Nicey is the mother of all 16 children, quite an accomplishment. Nicey's family has been traced back to Samuel Hawes who married Anne Spencer about 1712.

JOHN VINCENT (continued)

For those interested in how many ancestors joined in the Revolutionary War, Miss Kelly had about 10 ancestors with proof of service through which she became a life member of the D.A.R. John Vincent's wife's family, the Haweses, was one of them. We appear to have come from most of these Revolutionary War soldiers.

John Vincent moved to Lincoln County, Georgia as did most of his brothers and sisters. He eventually moved to Talladega County, Alabama and died there on May 13, 1871. Miss Kelly had a tombstone placed over John Vincent's grave, a goal she had hoped to achieve before her death.

SECTION D

AARON VINCENT AND MARGARET MISSOURI FINCH
 Their children and who their children married.

Aaron Vincent was born in Chambers County, Alabama on Feb 13, 1835. He married Margaret Missouri Finch on the 12th of Dec 1861. I've noticed that a lot of marriages seemed to have taken place shortly prior to the Civil War. Margaret was the daughter of William Finch and Lucinda Thompson. She was born in Wetumpka in Elmore County, Alabama in 1843. Her exact birth date is not known. Aunt Evelyn Vincent Farris used to speak of a "cuddin' (cousin) Vert Finch" but told me little about him.

Aaron served in the C.S.A in the 45th Alabama Regiment. Before the war Aaron had a store with a partner. While Aaron was away at battle his partner took everything. When the war was over, he was broke. He drove to his sister Louisa Vincent Bledsoe's in a one horse wagon with his wife and two children and stayed there a short time until he could get land. He then rented from his brother John, or lived there for several years and saved enough to buy near his brother Peyton. He bought and sold near what was known as Stockdale.

During his lifetime he purchased 838 acres in 11 different purchases all of section 14 containing the town of Old Field 3 1/2 miles Northeast of Sylacauga, Alabama. It appears that this land which he left to his widow and children (he died intestate) is the land known as the "Old Vincent Place" among living members of the family. Three of Aaron's children died childless, five left the state, and of the two remaining, one was committed to Bryce Hospital in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. This left only Oakley, Aaron's third child, to attend to the old home place.

Aaron Vincent's grave is located in the Oak Hill Cemetery in Talladega marked with an impressive marker erected by his youngest son, Grover. On the same marker is mentioned Grover's brother, Oyer, and his grandmother Lucinda (Thompson) Finch. They all died within a few months of each other, possibly from a flu epidemic. Aaron had 11 children. The two youngest, unnamed daughters, died in infancy.

Each of the following sections is dedicated to one of Aaron's children and their descendants. I'd like to urge all to please contact me if you'd like me to include names of Aaron's descendants not listed in this small work. My address is in Section A titled, "A word or two about the author"

SECTION E

#1 IDA VINCENT

Ida Vincent was the oldest child of Aaron Vincent and Margaret Missouri Finch. Ida was born in 1863. I don't know her exact birth date. I think the year of her birth may have been derived from census records. Ida never married. We learn a little about her from a letter she wrote to Maude Kelly on January 29, 1910 which is reproduced in part as follows:

"Dear Cousin Maud

Your letter came the other day and I was ever so glad to hear from you. I have answered your requests so far as I could and now I shall tell you something of myself.

I am living alone at the old home place -- where we lived when you visited us. I lived alone the greater part of last year. I have been left to depend upon my own resources the greater part of my life, so now I find it quite an easy matter to provide for myself. When living with any of the family, I have to care for them and provide for myself too and the task was greater than I could bear. Now, I work when I please and rest when I please which decidedly agrees with my health and inclinations. . . .

Ida goes on to tell Miss Kelly some information Miss Kelly had requested, then, in speaking of her grandfather, she shows a bit of humor:

"I am glad you have learned [John Vincent's] mother's name. . . . I am glad he had sisters and brothers. It clears the Vincents of illegitimacy in a direct way for four generations."

Then she shows a bit of disappointment in her family for lack of support to the unmarried:

"I wish there was some source, a provision for education and sustenance of any female member of the, or among the descendants of John and Nicie Vincent in case they should fail to marry or fail to get support from the proper sources; to protect them from the snares of evil people; that is legal descendants."

Sometime after this letter was written Miss Ida Vincent was committed to Bryce Hospital, the state mental institution, where she died on April 25th, 1920. My father, W.G. Vincent, says she allowed animals to run through her home, but he knew of nothing else unusual about her. She was an intelligent woman who taught school according to Evelyn Vincent Farris. My father tells me it was much easier to have someone committed in those days. I wrote the hospital to obtain the date of her death. They led me to believe Miss Ida was an ideal patient and well liked by the staff.

Miss Ida's brother, Oakley, was granted a summons in equity as administrator of her estate. I have the original summons dated 13th of June 1938. I also have a letter from Graves Embry (executor ?) dated October 27th, 1938 concerning settlement of Miss Ida's estate and her mother's estate, reproduced (including errors) as follows:

"Talladega, Ala.
Oct, 27th, 1938

Dear Sir. Enclosed find ck for \$14.92, distributive share of estate of of (sic) your mother, Mrs. M.M. Vincent. The amount paid me \$19.92, less \$5.00 fee. I am taking this amount, as I only got a nominamill (sic) fee in the estate of your sister, Niss (sic) Ida and (sic) made bond for your wife. Now as to what is left of your sisters estate \$13.00 that is in the hands of your wife. Think she should have this, if she provided things for Miss Ida while in hospital. Let that rest and if any thing comes up about any of the other children, let me know and will handle it for her.

SECTION F

#2 OYER VINCENT

I have a disappointingly small amount of information on Oyer. He was born October 3rd, 1866 in Talladega County, Alabama and died there March 7th, 1901, probably in the flu epidemic. Oyer never married. No military service is mentioned in any of the records. He is buried beside his father in Oak Hill Cemetery, Talladega, Alabama.

SECTION G

#3 OAKLEY VINCENT AND DESCENDENTS

Oakley was born the 16th of February, 1870. In a 1980 conversation I had with Thelma Barnett Vincent she said Oakley once told her he was born in Shelby County, Alabama near the Coosa River, near Vincent Township. She said the location is now part of Talladega County. The location she described is in the vicinity of the church where Oakley's grandfather, Reverend John Vincent is buried.

Oakley once told his daughter, Evelyn, that he didn't like the fact that he had only one name so he added an initial "D" before his given name. This accounts for the fact that his name is given "D.O. Vincent" in some records.

In a health insurance policy dated November 4th, 1922, the following statistics are given:

The policy provided payment for such things as broken ribs (\$5.00), amputation of a leg (\$20.00), and gunshot wounds (\$10.00).

According to applications for retirement, Oakley worked off and on for the Southern and L&N Railroads as flagman, brakeman, and car repairer from about November 1898 until December 9th, 1937. He was paid from \$100.00 a month (date unknown) to \$175.00 a month in 1930. His pay dropped to \$130.00 a month in 1931 probably due to the Great Depression.

I have two letters written by Oakley. One is to his wife, Penoma Ophelia Seay and the other is to his daughter Evelyn Vincent Farris. They are reproduced hereafter.

(NOTE: In reproducing these and other letters, it is generally a good rule to leave spelling, grammar, and punctuation errors intact to maintain originality.)

Dear Oma;

I have received 3 cards from you
This is ans. to your reques
I went home as usual Sat. weather good but
hot The boys came in Fri. night had a big
time but it did not seem like home and you
gone I don't know any thing to write every
thing about as you left it I am well and
Still on the Job we hauld in some Sills Sat.
for house Old man Swats had a Stroke and is
bout to die the Old woman over on the rad
was found dead I may have to go to Six days
a wek Some time Soon I Signed a contrack for
my Shack as a Dller per month and hope to
Stay there quite a while hope you will have
a big time but dont for get me I will close
with much Love

Dear Evelyn & John

I received your letter yes your
mother is in S. Highlands Hospitle and in a
bad condition has been there about 10 d and

#3 OAKLEY VINCENT AND DESCENDENTS
(continued)

On August 9th, 1906, Oakley Vincent married Penoma Ophelia Seay. He was 36 years old. She was 18. It is said that all his life he loved her dearly even when, in old age, she treated him badly.

Penoma Ophelia, or 'Oma' as she was called, descended from two very old and very Noble families. She was born the 18th of September, 1888 in Talladega, Alabama, the 2nd child of John Nathaniel Seay and Fannie Walker Pace. The Seay line has been researched by several people, most notably Judge B.W. Seay IV of Virginia who wrote "The Descendants of Abraham Seay". Judge Seay takes the family back to 1685 when Abraham Saye (Seay) fled from France to England to escape religious persecution. Abraham came to America about 1700.

Oma's father, John Nathaniel Seay, was a notable character. It is told of him that he was walking his girl home from church one Sunday and a dog ran up and bit him and tore his pants. He excused his girl, then went home and got his pistol, came back and shot the dog. He might have avoided trouble if the dog hadn't been sitting in the dogtrack (breezeway) of the home between its two owners at the time. Needless to say he had to flee to avoid a posse. It is said he moved to Texas and became a U.S. Marshall. He served in this capacity for 11 years but gave it up when he had to kill a man in Beaumont. He moved back to Alabama in a covered wagon about 1902 and was appointed Justice of the Peace in 1921. He died the 17th of July 1924 and is buried in the Seay Cemetery in Talladega as is his wife. I am told that James Nathaniel Vincent Jr. has John Seay's pistol. James's father, James Nathaniel Vincent Sr., was named for John Nathaniel Seay.

Oma Seay's mother was Fannie Walker Pace, Fannie's mother was Pauline Paulina (Jane) Seay. Andrew Gay (Sam) Vincent told me that Jane Seay's grandfather was Henry Seay. This contradict's what I have in Judge B.W. Seay's book.

Miss Kelly did some work on this line. I haven't looked at her research on these generations. My records in this area come from a pedigree Miss Kelly did for my father. If some of this information came from sources other than the reliable Miss Kelly, this may be an area for improvement.

Some marvel at the abundance of nick-names among the children of Oakley Vincent. The names come mostly from grandma (Fannie Walker) Pace. She gave nicknames to all of the grandchildren. Aaron was "Booster", Celia was "Bug", Oakley was "Bunk", Evelyn was "Took", Andrew Gay (Sam) was "Butler", William was "Doot", Wilburn was "Hap", and James was "Nat". No nickname is mentioned for Harry, the youngest. I got these names from Andrew Gay (Sam) Vincent and verified them in Miss Kelly's old records.

The Pace line is too extensive to go in to. For those who are interested, I refer them to "The Pace Society of America". Suffice it to say that Richard Pace was in Jamestown as early as April 1616 (Jamestown was less than 10 years old at the time).

People interested in the Pace family should contact the "Pace Society of America". I have no idea what their current address is. The last time I contacted them was in 1974. Back then Mr. Carl Dotson was vice-president in charge of membership. His address was 132 South Johnson Street, Pocatello, Idaho 83201. If you find this address to be not current, please contact me. I have a letter from Mr. Dotson containing many other contact addresses for the Pace Society.

Oakely died on the 4th of June, 1955 in Bessemer (mailing address), Alabama and Oma died in Irondale, Alabama on the 20th of June the same year. They were buried in Oak Hill Cemetery in Talladega, Alabama.

Oakley and Oma had 10 children. They and the grandchildren, and other descendants that I have record of are given on the following pages.

SECTION H

#4 ELMER VINCENT AND DESCENDANTS

Except for a few items, most of the information I have on Elmer Vincent is from his daughter, Geraldine (Gerry) Vincent Maple. In March of 1976 she published a "Vincent Family Tree" on the Elmer Vincent family. The book lists all Elmer's descendants known to Gerry at the time. Her oldest sister, Nona Mae, came back to Alabama on occasion to visit with my father and other relatives. Gerry got in touch with me through my father and included some of my research in her work. Without her efforts, this record would be sadly lacking in details of this, the largest branch of the Vincent family.

Elmer was a trusted member of the family and appeared to be close to his brother, Oakley. I have his signature on a promissory note for \$137.64 on the "isbell National Bank" dated January 6th, 1898. That was more than a month's pay back then. Only people in good standing with the community and with a good name could have borrowed that much. Incidentally, the note is marked, "Paid-in-full" and the date indicates it was paid off early.

In a conversation I had with Evelyn Farris in 1977 she told me that Elmer sold a mortgaged cow and had to move because, back then, it was an unfavorable thing to do. As most Vincents of his generation seemed to be, Elmer had the education and intelligence to do whatever he wanted. According to his daughter Gerry, he worked at various jobs across the country. He taught school, worked in the coal mines, and in his later years, went into the cement business with his sons Bill, Ocie, Harold, and Raymond.

Gerry has it in her work that Elmer was born in Anniston, Alabama on the 10th of March 1872. The location may be in error. In May of 1870, according to the 1870 census, his family was living in Talladega County not too far from Childersburg. Since Elmer's Father, Aaron, bought and sold land around this area all his life and since most people back then were born at home, Elmer was probably born in Talladega County between the towns of Vincent and Talladega where his brother, Oakley was born. However, Anniston is not too far away. This is where Elmer married Nettie Warren about 1897. Nettie was born in Anniston on March 7th, 1882, according to Gerry. Elmer and Nettie had 13 children. Elmer died September 3rd, 1956 in National City, California, Nettie died 17 August 1976 and they're both buried in San Diego, California.

SECTION J

#5 ALVIN VINCENT AND DESCENDANTS

According to Maude Kelly, Alvin served in the 1st Ala. in the Spanish American War. In 1981, Alvin's son, Clarence, told me this little bit of history about his father.

"He moved to Bessemer in 1918 or 1919 and bought a shoe shop (called 'Vincent's Shoe Shop') from his brother, Ullman which was located in Thompson Town. He closed it in a few months when he heard of a shoe shop in Jonesboro which he bought.

I don't know much else on the history of Alvin Vincent. He was born in Talladega County Aug 16th, 1873, he married Nancy Elizabeth Solley on the 8th of Jan 1906 by whom he had 3 children, and he died on the 19th of November 1961. I recall my dad taking us to visit him when I was a boy. He was a jolly fellow who (he told me) went bowling every day. He was in his eighties at the time and I wondered if I would be as spry when I was his age. My grandfather, Oakley, is said to have plowed with a mule and planted until a few years before his death at age 85, so I guess it runs in the family.

Miss Kelly shows Alvin's wife as "Lizzie Tucker". The problem with the surname was resolved by Clarence. His mother was married to a man named John Tucker before marrying Alvin. Elizabeth Solley's parents were Daniel Marion Solley and Nancy Ann Thatcher. Elizabeth was born the 26th of October, 1886 in Hackneyville, Alabama and died in 1949. I don't know the location of her death but since Alvin died in Coleville in Harrison County, Mississippi, perhaps Elizabeth died there also. Alvin's 3 children and a daughter of Elizabeth and John Tucker and their descendants are listed on the next page, as far as I have knowledge.

SECTION K

#6 JOHN WILLIAM VINCENT AND DESCENDANTS

The earliest record I have of John William Vincent is his signature on a promissory note dated 1907. He is cosigning with Oakley for \$60.00. I don't know what the loan is for. I don't have much else on John. His children seemed to have made their impression on their cousins, though. Aaron Walker Vincent said he saw John William's son, Earl, tap dance once. Clarence, Alvin's son, said Earl was a drifter and never worked, that he lived all over the country, and that he made his living entertaining in night clubs in New York. Elizabeth Vincent Grogan, Earl's sister told me in 1981 that Earl either had a stroke or was dead, she didn't know which.

John William Vincent was born September 19th, 1880 in Talladega, Al. He married the 22nd of December 1904 to Jessie Lee Nunis. She was born in Eastaboga, Al. John died in 1955 and Jessie died in 1956. They're buried in Montezuma, Ga.

SECTION L

#7 ULLMAN LEWELLYN VINCENT AND DESCENDANTS

Ullman Lewellyn Vincent was an educated and a religious man. Like his other brothers and sisters he taught school at one time (I'm not sure when, but Evelyn Farris said in 1977 that he was a school teacher). His daughter, Margaret, told me he went to school for two years and became a Methodist Minister. He later joined the Jehovah's Witnesses. Evelyn Farris said he was a minister in that church also. Miss Kelly gives the following:

"Alabama Christian Advocate, Aug 9, 1928, p6,col 4
from Greenboro Watchman 25 years ago:
at the Methodist District Conference at Marion
last week the following were granted license to
preach . . . Ullman T (sic) Vincent"

If it was 25 years ago in 1928, that would make it about 1903 that he was ordained. He was 25 years old then. It was his shoe shop that his brother, Alvin bought in 1918 or 1919, therefore, he must have given up the ministry before then, that is, in the Methodist Church. His grandfather, John was a Methodist Minister. At the time of the shoe shop ownership, he lived in a place called Thompson Town. Clarence Vincent gives this description,

"They lived about three miles out of Bessemer,
1/2 mile west of Thompson Town which was 2
miles south of Bessemer."

It was at Ullman's house in Bessemer, in 1920 that his mother, Margaret Missouri Finch died according to Clarence. The Death Certificate shows the address as 400 2nd Ave in Bessemer but Clarence says this is in error.

Ullman Lewellyn Vincent was born September 22nd, 1878 in Sylacauga, Alabama according to his daughter, Margaret. He married about 1907 to Martha Elizabeth (Mattie) Glawson. She was born Jun 10th, 1887. Their death dates are not known, but they are buried at Oak Lawn Cemetery in Ft. Valley, Ga.

The only thing I have from the family on Aunt Ruby is from Evelyn Farris who told me that, like the others, Ruby taught school. I have a copy of an interesting letter Ruby wrote to Maude Kelly from which I have included the following excerpts:

Your letter was quite a surprise as well as a great pleasure, and I hope you wont mind a typewritten reply. . . .

I don't remember Uncle Peyton but they lived somewhere in Talladega Co. I think. If you could get in touch with Rosa Vincent, Cropwell, Ala. she probably would know something of value. I believe she was married, but to whom I do not know. I think she is Uncle Peyton's grand daughter. . . .

I often heard Father speak of his mother, but I think she died when he was a small boy, and it is my impression that his family lived somewhere in Ga. near the Ala. line. I think Pennington, and 5 of his sisters died rather young.

I remember Aunt Rhuey (I was named for her) lived near us when I was born about 3 miles from Kymulga, Ala. But I believe she moved from there, it seems Talladega, but I am not sure.

"Arthur, my husband, died two years ago after five years sickness. I just have the two girls, Billie and Ruth. Billie works in a cotton broker's office while Ruth is still looking for something to do. I am still carrying on the business we started before Arthur died. . . .

Give my love to cousin Leonie, and tell her I would like so much to see her again. Any time I can be of any help don't hesitate to write me.

Billie Wiebens married John S. King and Ruth Wiebens married a Kailing. No one I've talked to knows any more about this branch of the family. I'd like very much to know more.

SECTION N

#9 GROVER CLEVELAND VINCENT

Miss Kelly shows that Grover was in the "militia" (the Army) in 1905. Grover attended the University of Alabama and graduated from there in 1908 with a degree in Civil Engineering. Whether he was actually in the Army in 1905 or he returned after he graduated, I do not know. He served in World War I as a 1st Lieutenant, Transportation Corps, and was Honorably discharged at Camp Gordon, Georgia, September 8th, 1919. His Discharge shows no record of combat.

He worked as a Civil Engineer for the old Atlantic Coast Line Railroad in Wilmington, N.C.; at Davis Shores (Tampa-in-the-Bay) Tampa, Fl.; Davis Shores in St. Augustine, Fl.; Missouri Pacific Railroad, St. Louis, Mo.; and the State Highway Department of Iowa, until his illness with tuberculosis in the spring of 1929.

Once again, like many others, I was told that Grover taught school. This generation of Vincent's was well educated for the time. Many people of this period lacked a high school diploma but some of this generation of Vincent's had some college.

He contracted tuberculosis at a time when the cause was not known. He entered the Black Mountain Sanatorium, Black Mountain, N.C. where he spent one year then entered the Veteran's Administration Hospital in Oteen, N.C. and spent the rest of his life there.

Grover Cleveland Vincent was born on January 31 1886 in Talladega, Alabama. He married Laura Hill Jacobs on December 27th, 1923 and died the 5th of May 1968 in Oteen, North Carolina. Laura was the daughter of Charles Deem Jacobs and Mary Eliza Willis. She was born on April 26th, 1895, in Willmington, North Carolina. and died there on October 27th, 1966. They had no children.
