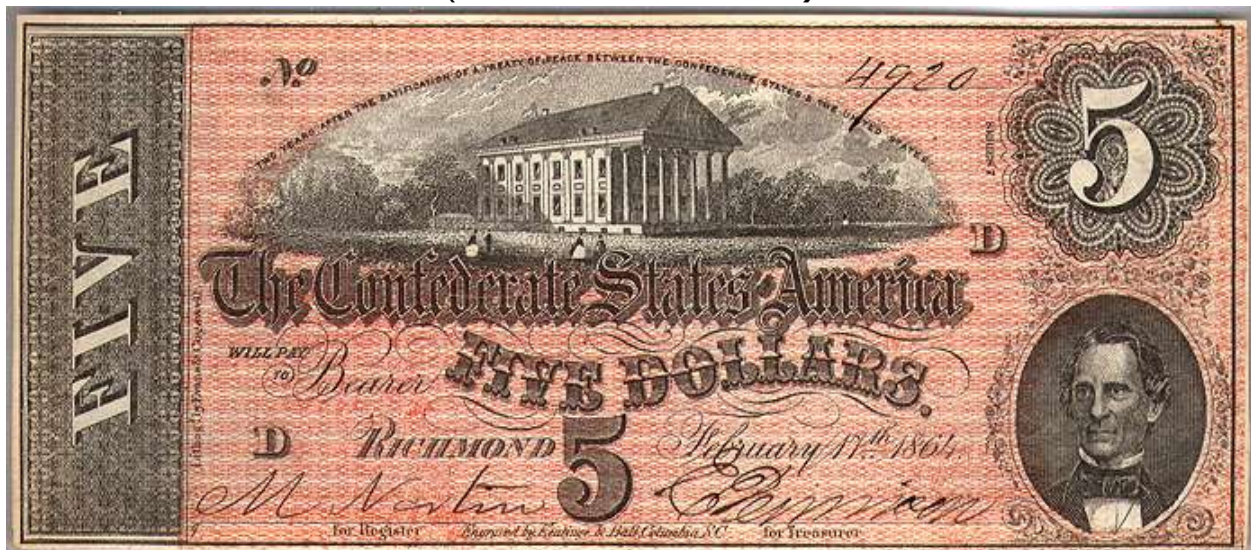


Confederate \$5.00 note given to Doris Virginia Warren (1924 – 2001) by her grandfather Joseph Benjamin Blake (1869 – 1947) which he received as the final payment on a cow he sold to a neighbor. The bill was worthless at the time he received it so he carried it in his pocket for the rest of his life until he gave it to his granddaughter.

The bill is dated Richmond [VA] February 17th, 1864. It promises to pay the bearer \$5 "two years after the ratification of a treaty of peace between the Confederate States and the United States."
